






# Caring For Your Water Dispenser Upon Returning To Work


The following advice has been produced to make sure your dispenser is ready for immediate use when you return.


## Bottled Coolers

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1 Ensure the power supply is turned on.
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2 Remove the existing bottle from the cooler and drain the remaining water from both taps.
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3 Fit a new bottle onto the cooler and dispense 5 litres through both taps.
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4 Sanitise the taps and dispensing area with food safe sanitiser spray or wipes.
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5 The dispenser is now ready for use.

## Mains Fed Coolers

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1 Ensure the power and water supply is turned on.
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
2 Dispense 5 litres of water to refresh the system.
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
3 Sanitise the taps and dispensing area with food safe sanitiser spray or wipes.
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4 The dispenser is now ready for use.


## Hot Water Boilers

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1 Whilst the boiler is turned off, sanitise the taps and dispensing area with food safe sanitiser spray or wipes.
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2 Turn the power and water supply on and dispense the first tank of water.
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3 Leave for 30 minutes to re-heat and re-fill.
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4 Once again dispense the second tank of water to refresh the system.
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5 The boiler is now ready for use.
